



The goal of Student Health Service is to promote the health and well being of students of UT Southwestern Medical Center.

SERVICES OFFERED

Student Health Service provides acute, chronic and preventive care. Services are similar to a family practice clinic and include:

- **Episodic Illness and Minor Trauma:**
Examples: *Upper respiratory infections, urinary tract infections, poison ivy, muscle strain and sprains*
- **Management of Routine Medical Problems:**
Examples: *acne, hypertension, allergic rhinitis, hypothyroidism, hyperlipidemia*
- **Complete Physical Examinations**
- **Women's Health Care:** Well-woman exams, contraception, gynecologic problems (*Referral for obstetrical care can be provided*)
- **Mental Health Services** (*see additional information in this brochure*)
- **Immunizations and Skin tests:** Tetanus, flu shots and tuberculin skin tests are provided to enrolled students. Immunizations and skin tests required for pre-matriculation are not provided. While enrolled, other vaccinations such as Hepatitis A & B, Varicella and MMR can be administered after purchase of the vaccine from a pharmacy.
- **Travel:** Information, vaccines and medications in preparation for foreign travel

APPOINTMENTS

Office visits are by appointment. To schedule an appointment, call 214-645-8690.

Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 AM to 12 PM and 1 PM to 5 PM.

Same day appointments can generally be arranged.

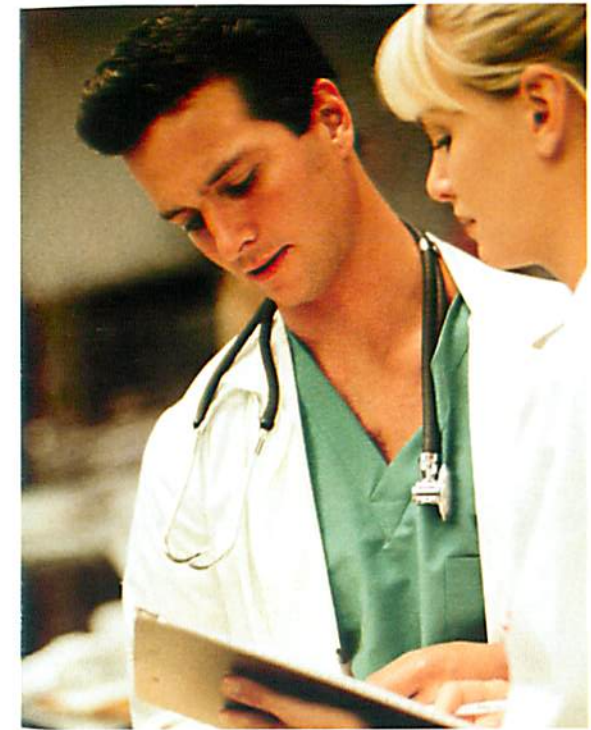
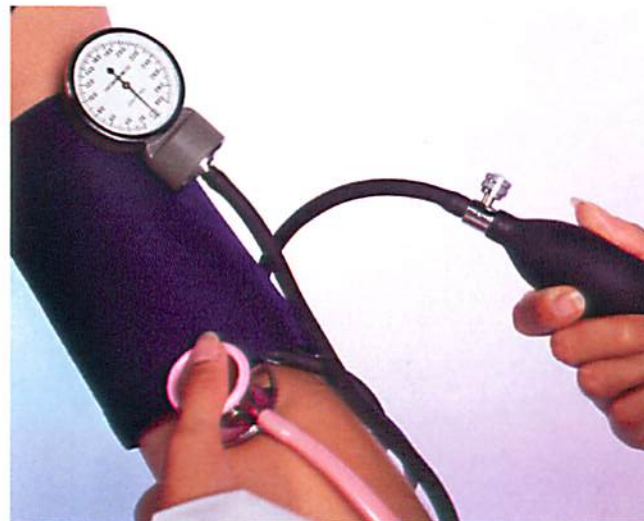
INSURANCE AND FEES

Services in Student Health are covered by student activity fees. However, any service provided outside of Student Health including referrals to specialty clinics, labs and radiology services are the responsibility of the student.

All students are required to OBTAIN and MAINTAIN health insurance coverage while enrolled at UT Southwestern Medical Center. Students need to be knowledgeable of the specific coverage of their own individual plans. Insurance plans vary and not all services are covered.

AFTER HOURS CARE

In the event an urgent problem occurs after hours, students may call the answering service at 214-645-8690 for assistance.



STAFF

The services of student health are provided by a health care provider and support staff. A faculty member and provider in the division of the William T. and Gay F. Solomon General Internal Medicine Clinic of the UT Southwestern Medical Center is medical director.

CONFIDENTIALITY

All visits to Student Health and Student Mental Health are confidential and are covered by FERPA, the Family Education Record and Privacy Act, in addition to HIPPA. Information regarding visits is not released to UT Southwestern Medical Center staff or faculty without the student's permission.

EMERGENCY

Student Health Service does not provide emergency care. Students who are experiencing a medical emergency should go to UT Southwestern University Hospital, St. Paul Emergency Services or to the nearest emergency services. Inform the emergency staff that you are a student at UT Southwestern and ask that Student Health Service be contacted at 214-645-8690.

STUDENT MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

Mental Health Services are provided by UT Southwestern Medical Center psychiatrists and are absolutely confidential.

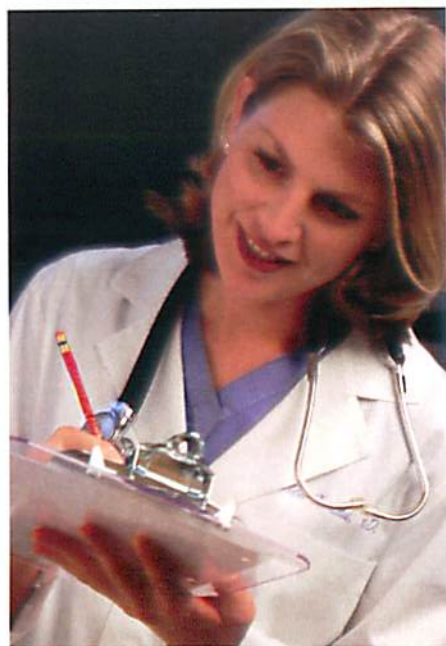
Services available include:

- Evaluation for a variety of psychiatric conditions including anxiety, mood disturbances, adjustment disorders, and interpersonal problems
- Brief psychotherapy sessions, individual counseling, crisis intervention, marital/family counseling, and medication follow-up
- Referral for specific evaluation tests or for psychotherapy with a provider as required by specific conditions

Visits with a psychiatrist are by appointment only. To schedule an appointment, call 214-645-8680.

LOCATION

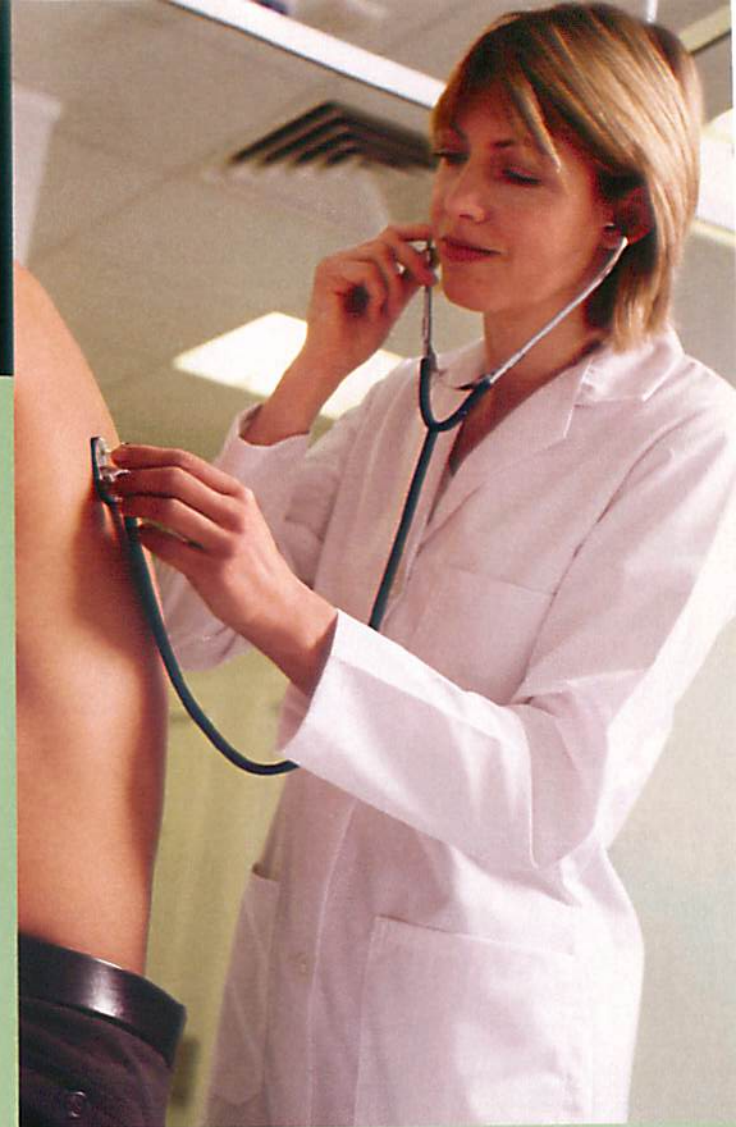
Student Health Service is located on the eighth floor, room 409 (U8.409,) of the James W. Aston Ambulatory Care Center on South Campus.
