- Individuals with autism (1 in 58)
- Ages 18-30
- Require a GED

➤ Services Provided

- Teach life skills such as driving, cooking, and calling doctor's offices.
- Help students obtain and retain jobs through internships

➤ Clients' Health Needs

- Obesity is a main issue the clients face
- Anxiety is very common
- Self-image
- Emotional/Social support system

➤ Clients' Health Information Needs

- Many have been dependent on parents all their life, so medical knowledge is minimal
- Some do not know what requires medical attention and what does not.

➤ Advice for Physicians

- Every individual with Autism expresses it uniquely.
- The best way to become comfortable and familiar with autism, is to work with individuals with autism regularly.
- A more relaxed manner is the best approach when working with individuals with autism.
- Individuals with autism should not be expected to initiate conversation
