Rural Health Scholarship for Public Health Students

About the Scholarship

The School of Population and Public Health (SPPH) seeks to recruit and train public health professionals who are dedicated to serving rural areas of Texas. This scholarship is for a minimum of \$2500 for students who do their APE or other qualifying on-the-ground rural coursework in the semester of the scholarship award.

Eligibility Requirements

- Current MPH student enrolled full-time in MPH program
- Planning to complete APE or other qualifying course project in rural site in the semester applying for the scholarship

Note: Recipients must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA or the award may be withdrawn. Students that receive a 3.0 or better in a future semester may reapply for the scholarship.
