

HRPP Education and Training Overview

The TTUHSC HRPP policy requires that **all** Principal Investigators, Co-Investigators, and research study personnel are required to receive training regarding the protection of Human Subject research and financial conflicts of interests. **This training must be completed prior to beginning any human research-related activities.**

HRPP POLICY APPLIES TO:

- **All research study personnel** who engage (or plan to engage) in Human Subject Research.
- **All research involving human subjects**, regardless of funding or sponsorship.

Failure to Comply

The IRB has the authority to **suspend or withhold approval** from any project that involves study personnel who fail to meet these education requirements.

Prerequisites for Being Involved in Human Subject Research

1) Complete the HRPP training requirements:

2) Have/maintain an active Cayuse account (with Human Ethics access):

- **If you NEED Cayuse access:** Both of the HRPP required training (CITI and COIC) **MUST** be complete/current before Cayuse access can be granted.
- **If you ALREADY HAVE Cayuse access:** Both of the HRPP required training (CITI and COIC) **MUST** be complete/current in order to maintain Cayuse access.

3) Be familiar with the HRPP Manual:

- In addition to completing the HRPP training requirements and maintaining an active Cayuse account, all research study personnel are also required to be familiar with the [HRPP Manual](#).

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
