Senate Resolution 19.19

(Stating the sentiments of the Student Senate regarding a reduction in discretionary spending of tuition funds at TTUHSC)

WHEREAS, student debt is a well-known problem that should be minimized wherever possible, and

WHEREAS, savings generated by reducing frivolous spending at TTUHSC could potentially lead to lower tuition, effectively lessening the debt burden placed on students upon graduation, and

WHEREAS, students deserve the right to voice concerns over future spending on projects that directly affect them, and

WHEREAS, school resources should be spent wisely in the direct benefit of student education,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Student Senate of Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center ask that discretionary spending at TTUHSC is looked after more closely and reduced where appropriate for the purpose of lowering student debt to improve the financial outlook of students now and upon graduation.
