



Parent Institution Letter (PIL)

What is a Parent Institution Letter (PIL):

- A Parent Institution is the primary school from which the student will earn their degree.
- A Supplemental Institution is the school in which the student plans to enroll in courses which will satisfy requirements at the Primary Institution.

In order to approve benefits for enrollment, the Supplemental Institution must receive confirmation from the Parent Institution that a student may receive credit in their approved educational program for the course(s) they plan to take.

Student Responsibilities:

1. Student should gain approval from their Academic Dean before enrolling in courses at another school.
2. List the name, number and description of the course(s) you are enrolling in at the Supplemental Institution.
3. Submit this PIL form to the School Certifying Official (SCO) at Veteran&MilitaryServices@ttuhsc.edu.
4. Contact the SCO at the Supplemental Institution to verify receipt of the PIL and follow any additional instructions provided.
5. The Supplemental Institution's SCO will certify the approved courses taken there.
6. For classes taken concurrently at TTUHSC, submit the appropriate benefit request.
7. Request an official transcript be sent to the appropriate school official once the supplemental course grades have been posted.
